A paperless, electronic transaction that goes through the Automated Clearing House and transfers money from one bank to another. Could be credits (deposits) or debits (withdrawals)

WHAT IS AN AUTOMATED GIVER ?

A parishioner, who through prayer and reflection, chooses an automated way to exercise good financial stewardship by having his/her weekly offering electronically delivered to the parish.
